Maximum dimensions and weight allowed on an annual oversize/overweight permit is length - 120', width - 13'5", height - 15'5", weight - 156,000 pounds. Enter actual dimensions if self-propelled oversize/overweight vehicle.

This permit is valid only for travel on state and U.S. highways in Iowa. It is not valid for travel on interstate highways, county roads or city streets. Separate permits must be obtained from the proper governing authority for travel on these roadways.

Carrier will receive Bridge Embargo Maps, a Pavement Restrictions Map, and Vertical Clearance Maps and a log. Information is also available at [www.iowadot.gov/mvd/omcs](http://www.iowadot.gov/mvd/omcs) and [www.511ia.org](http://www.511ia.org). It is the responsibility of the carrier to route themselves around low clearances, construction projects, embargoed roads and bridges. If carrier demonstrates inability to self-issue, the permit will be revoked.

Permits can be issued only for transporting single articles that exceed statutory size, unless the inclusion of additional articles does not cause the size or weight to exceed further the statutory limits.

Disclosure Statement: The information furnished on this application will be used by the Department of Transportation to prepare and issue permits. All information applicable to a given permit is required and is public information. Failure to complete the application as required will result in denial of permit. Permit issuing authorities will not be responsible for any damages that are the result of the move. The State of Iowa, the Department of Transportation, and any other permit issuing authority assume no responsibility for the property of the permit holder.
