* "Rescue vehicle" means a motor vehicle which is equipped with rescue, fire, or life support equipment used to assist and rescue persons in emergencies or support emergency personnel in the performance of their duties.

"Fire vehicle" means a motor vehicle which is equipped with pumps, tanks, hoses, nozzles, ladders, generators, or other fire apparatus used to transport fire personnel, fight fires, and respond to emergencies.

** "Special equipment" means equipment installed on a motor truck which, in combination with the motor truck on which the equipment is installed, constitutes a self-contained unit configured for a specific purpose. To constitute special equipment, a minimum of \$7,500 or 25 percent of the retail value of the motor truck, whichever is greater, must be expended in installing the equipment on the motor truck, including the cost of the equipment. "Special equipment" does not include equipment designed for the transportation of passengers.

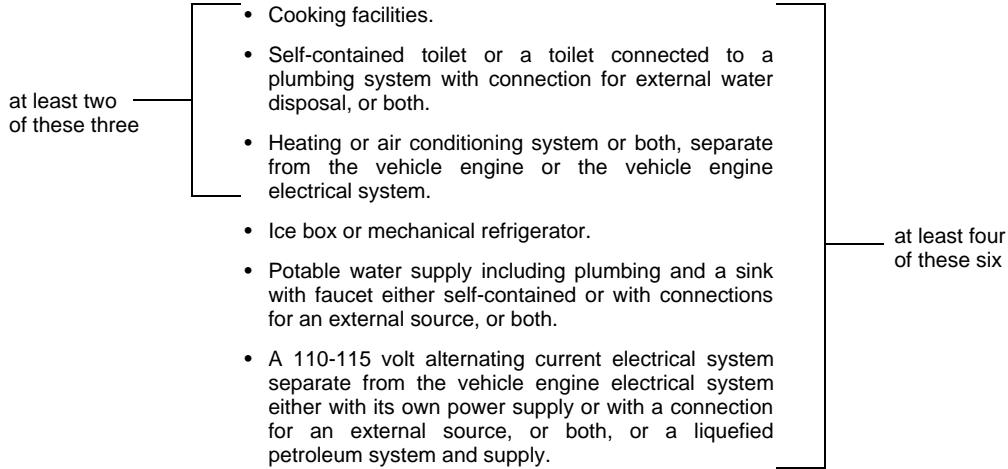

7. Attach a copy of a completed manufacturer's certificate of origin issued by your firm that complies with the federal standards:

For 1992 and subsequent model year vehicles, the form used for manufacturers' certificates of origin shall be the universal form adopted in 1990 by the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA). This requirement does not apply to trailer-type vehicles.

MOTORIZED BICYCLE: The description of a motorized bicycle shall specify the maximum speed on the MCO. The maximum speed should not exceed 30 mph.

LOW SPEED VEHICLES: The manufacturer's or importer's certificate shall certify that the vehicle was manufactured in compliance with the national highway traffic safety administration standards for low-speed vehicles in 49 C.F.R. 571.500.

MOTOR HOMES: Manufacturer's certificates of origin issued on motor homes must indicate whether the motor home is class A, B, or C. All units classified as a class A, B, or C motor home and delivered to Iowa dealers must contain the required systems as outlined below and all systems installed must meet ANSI and NFPA standards:



8. Each vehicle must have the manufacturer's label pursuant to Chapter 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) PT 567 certifying that the vehicle meets the federal motor vehicle safety standards. By signing this application you are certifying that the vehicles do comply with this requirement.
9. Manufacturer's certificates of origin issued on travel trailers must show the length and width of the trailer.
10. A manufacturer or importer shall not directly or indirectly be licensed as, own an interest in, operate, or control a motor vehicle dealer. This does not apply to manufacturers of motor homes exclusively. List business name and license number if licensed as a motor vehicle dealer.

I hereby certify, under penalty of perjury and pursuant to the laws of the State of Iowa, that the preceding is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and that I am certified to operate as a manufacturer, distributor, or new vehicle wholesaler in the State of Iowa. I understand that the issuance of a license of the type I have requested is subject to suspension and revocation if I fail to comply with Iowa's laws and administrative rules.
